- All students will now have two math homework papers most nights (fact page and a practice page). Our class has ALL brought in math homework 5 days in a row! Woo Hoo!

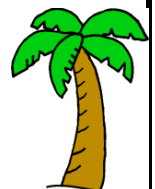
Ask Your Child
